The 250 year old waterways need constant upkeep and investment. Without it, they face decline and closure, and we risk losing the incredible benefits they bring.



How did you spend your day?

The section of canal we worked on was amidst a backdrop of warehouses and the underside of a railway bridge. We spent the day clearing the overgrown flora, which was reminiscent of the Amazon rainforest!

We cleared nettles and small trees that were encroaching onto the path, then removed the offcuts for natural decomposition. After a solid day of manual work, the canal regained its natural beauty thanks to the KPS Liverpool team.

How did you feel about volunteering?

We enjoyed our day volunteering for the Canal & River Trust. It was great to spend the day with colleagues in a different environment to the office and also outside with nature. I definitely felt we bonded as a team.

The weather was wet, but it didn't stop us getting on with the task in hand, and we could see the results at the end of the day. The towpaths looked a lot clearer, and we knew the local community would also reap the benefits.
