

CREATING A TEAM PAGE ON JUSTGIVING



JustGiving Team Pages allow you and your friends to join your individual fundraising pages together to contribute to an overall total.

They're great if you want to raise money separately whilst still contributing to a larger team goal. The page will list everyone's individual page, as well as the charity you're raising money for, and the collective total you've raised together.

- Give your team a name and click 'Let's go!'

Team members will be able to connect their own fundraising pages to the team page.

- Provide the story behind your reason to fundraise together and add a cover photo. Once you are happy click 'continue'.

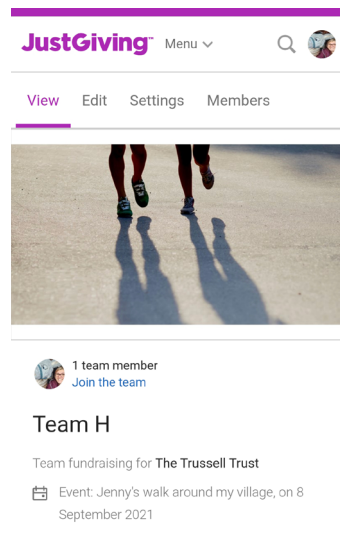

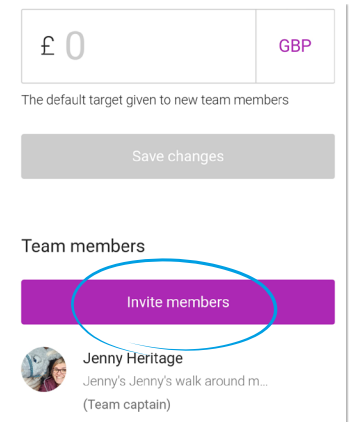

- You should then see something like this and your team page is created

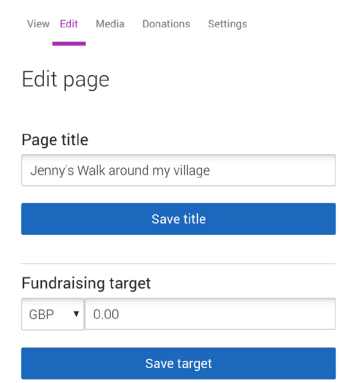


- o Invite new members

- Go to your team page
- Click 'edit' at the top of the page
- You can update the following:
 - o Title of your team page
 - o Your target
 - o Your cover story
 - o Your team photo

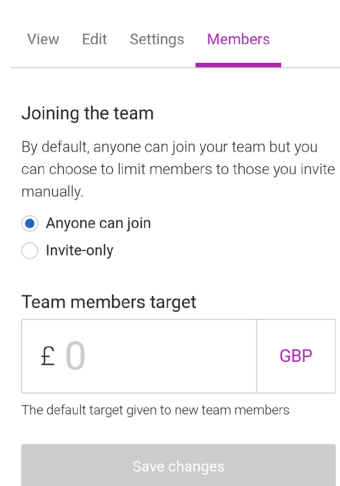
