Generate £1,000,000 worth of social value per year through fundraising, volunteering and gift in kind support. To do this we will:

Raise £500,000 and donate per annum through Kier Foundation schemes

Encourage Kier people to focus on their own wellbeing and be part of something special:

- We will organise two Group wide events per year with their overall wellbeing in mind
- Give Kier people the opportunity to volunteer for causes and community projects through the Kier volunteering policy,
 two days for each employee per year
- Create a community of 400 champions and ambassadors of the Foundation and promote Kier's social purpose



£300k raised to date (against a £200k goal) to support EYH Employability and Housing Fund our new goal is £400k




SHAPING HOMES
